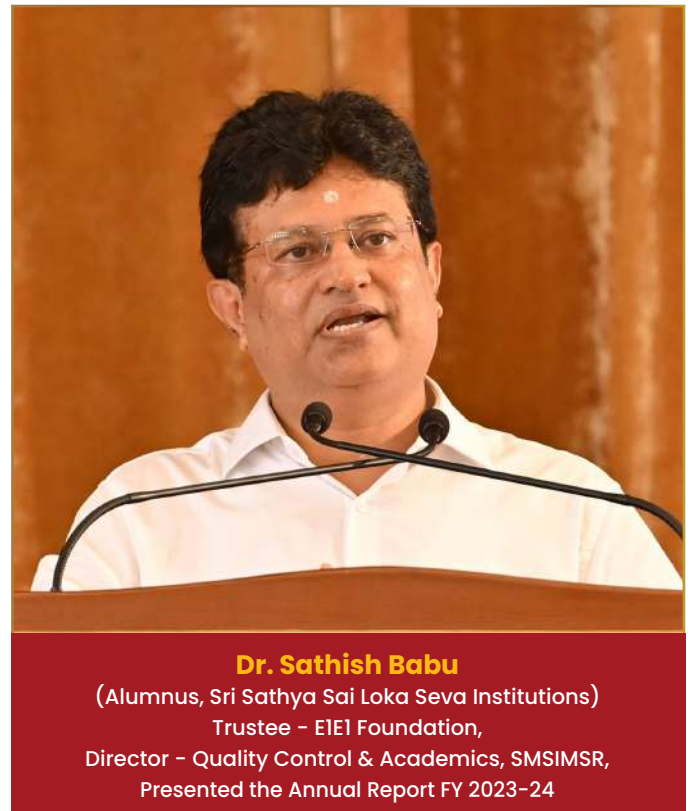

STELLAR ACADEMIC RESULTS FROM SMSIMSR

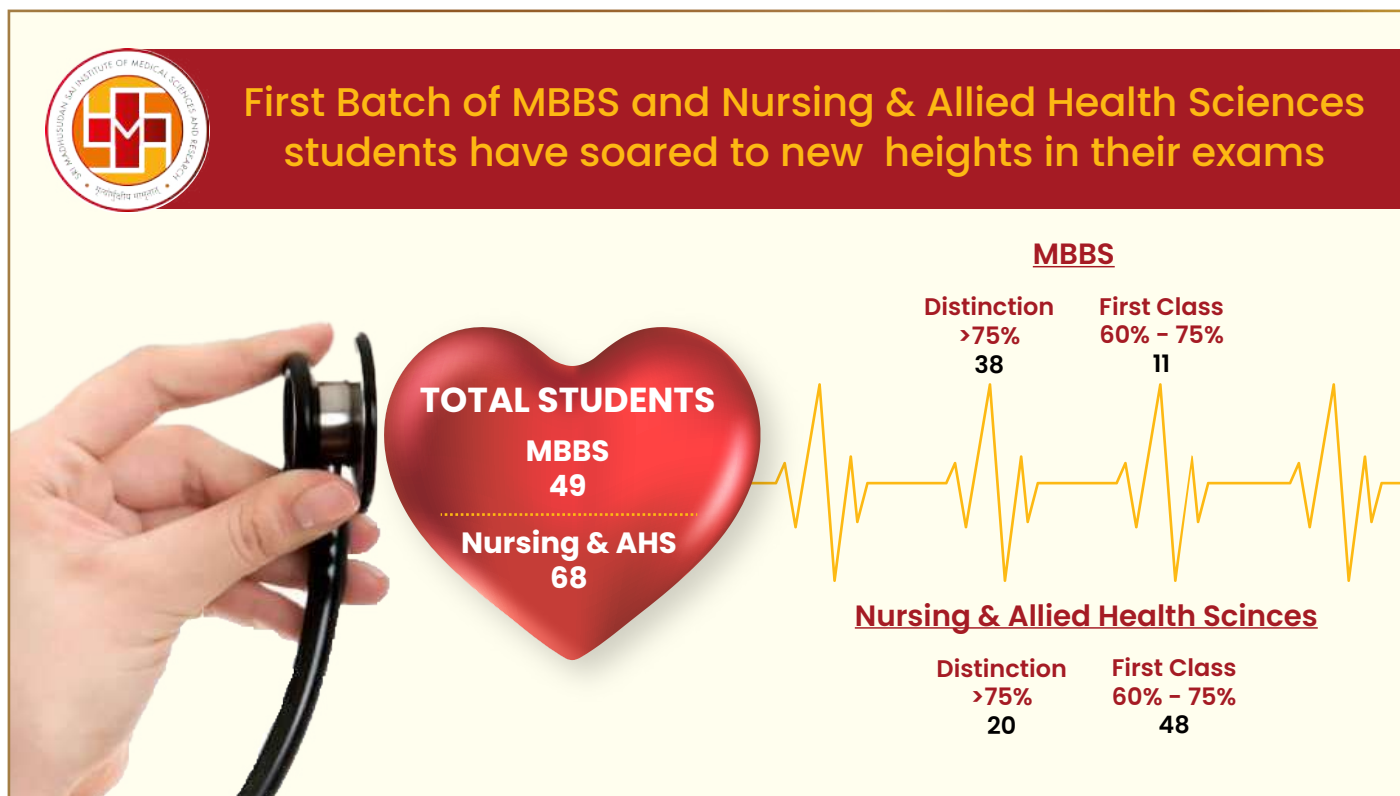

DIPLOMA IN INTEGRATED AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES

SSSUHE launched a new academic program, Diploma in Integrated Agricultural Sciences, specifically designed to inspire and empower rural youth with a passion for agriculture. The Diploma program spans two years, followed by a mandatory one-year internship. 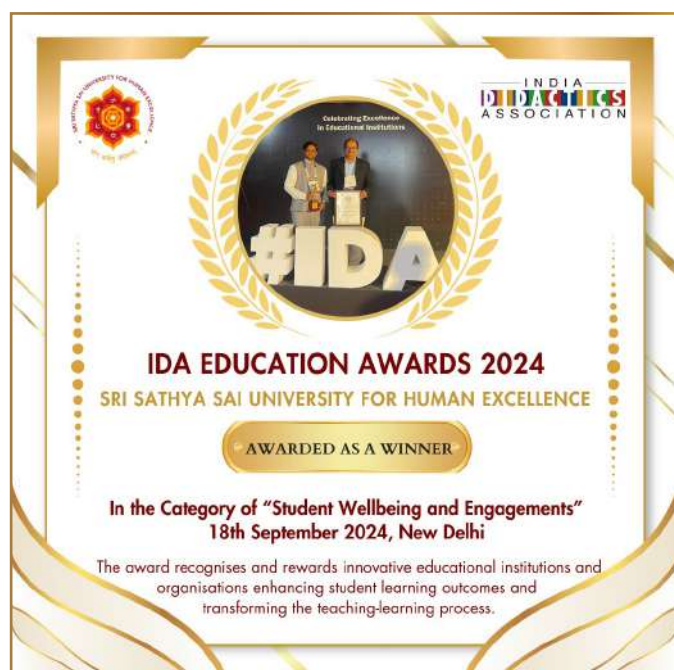

Leadership' to the UG students there, followed by a lively interactive session.

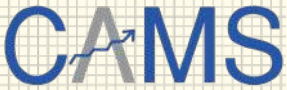

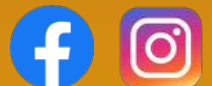
