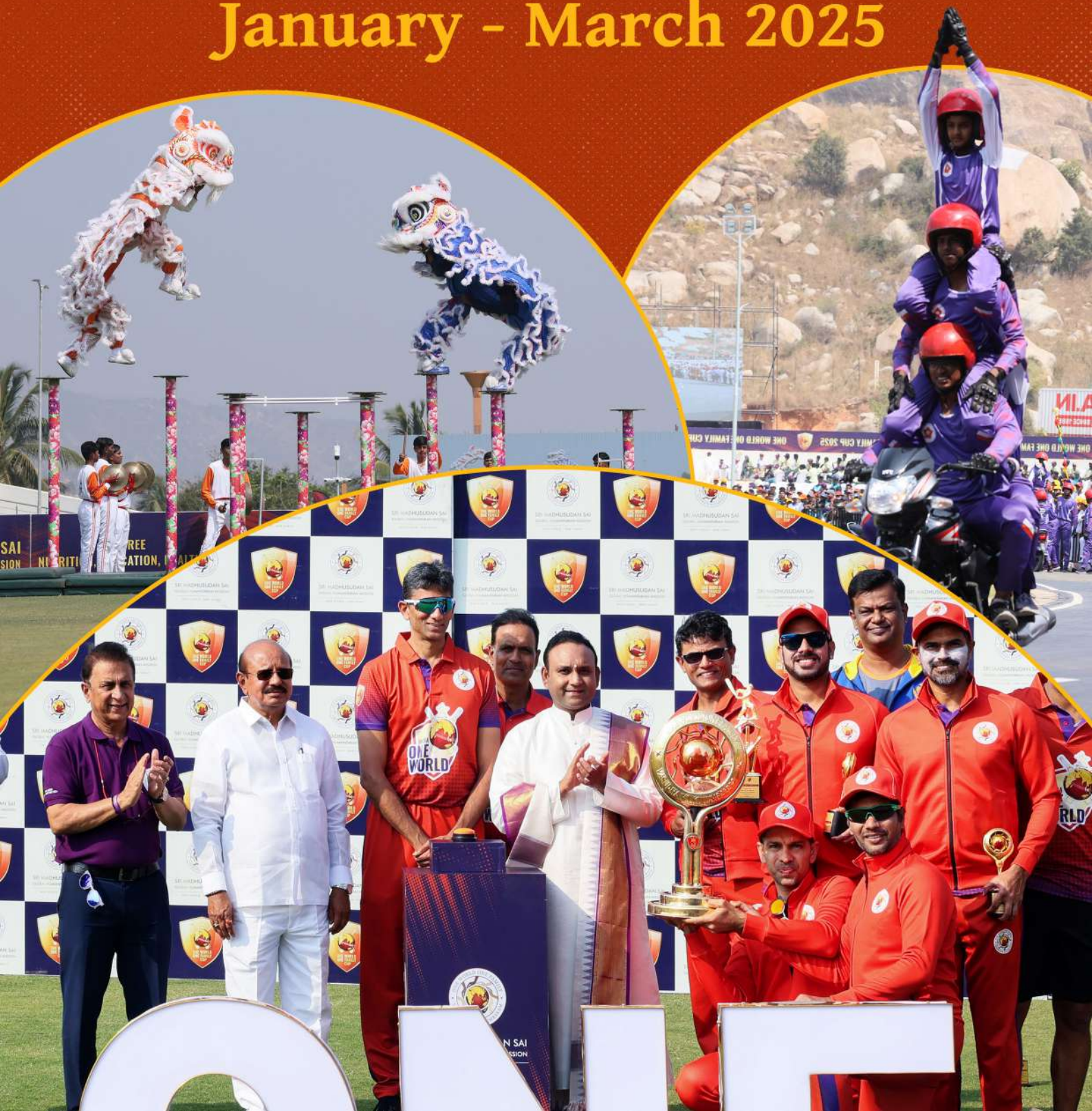

Founded in the name of India's greatest cricketing legends - Sri Gundappa Vishwanath and Sri Sunil Gavaskar, this academy is dedicated to nurturing young talent and upholding the values of discipline, sportsmanship, and dedication.

In India, world - class cricket training is often concentrated in urban centres, making

it difficult for young aspirants from rural backgrounds to access top - tier coaching and facilities. The Vishwanath Gavaskar Cricket Academy is committed to breaking this barrier by providing professional coaching, infrastructure, and mentorship - completely free-of-charge to deserving youngsters from underserved communities.

This initiative is a game - changer, ensuring that every child with a dream gets a fair chance to shine on the field, regardless of background or financial status.

Program Details

- **Eligibility Criteria:** Open to boys aged 10 years (as on 31st Mar 2025) and above, and those who have completed 5th level academic studies.
- **Fully residential programme:** all expenses covered for selected students, removing financial barriers to high-quality cricket training.
- **Course Duration:** Three years (1st Phase)
- All those selected for the Cricket Academy will be required to pursue academic education under NIOS scheme at the facility available at Sri Sathya Sai Loka Seva Gurukulam Muddenahalli, Chikkaballapur
- Selected participants are required to follow the norms of Gurukulam and the routine prescribed.

The program is set to commence shortly for this academic year, and admissions are now closed.

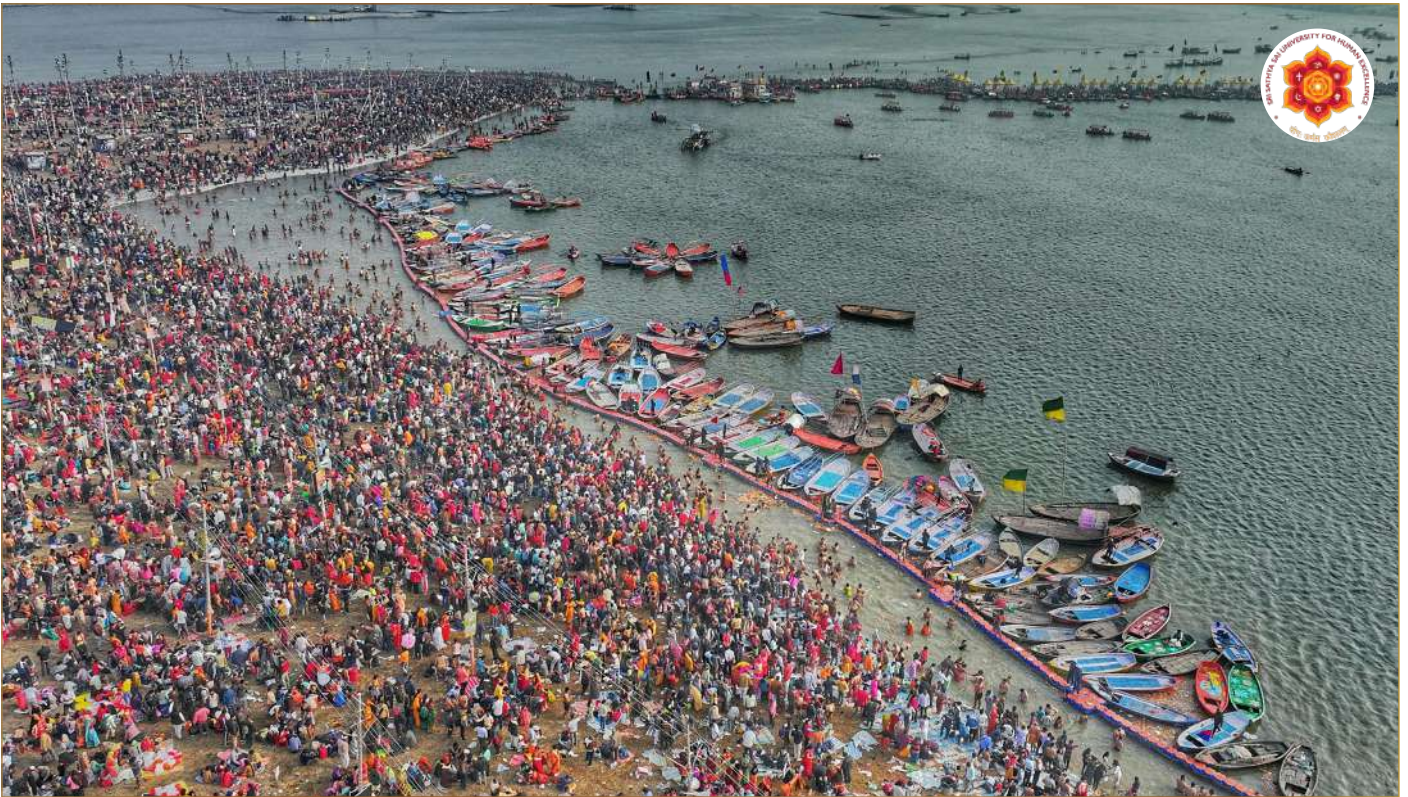

All-India Vice-Chancellors Conference Hosted by SSSUHE



The Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence (SSSUHE) hosted the All-India Vice - Chancellors Conference on February 24, 2025, in Sathya Sai Grama, Muddenahalli, Karnataka. The conference was themed on "Values - Based Education in the Indian Context," with the aim to integrate ethical and moral values into higher education.

The event brought together 50 Vice-Chancellors from 47 state and private universities across 18 states that included Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Haryana, Jammu and Kashmir, Jharkhand, Karnataka, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, Meghalaya, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and West Bengal.

Sri Madhusudan Sai, the founder of SSSUHE, emphasized the need to realign the education system with the ancient Indian principle of dedicating oneself to the welfare of all. He highlighted the concept of "Dharma," advocating the making of righteous choices and fostering happiness among students. The Chancellor Sri B N Narasimha Murthy underscored the importance of integrating

wisdom and human values in education. He called for passionate educators, supported by policymakers, to confidently introduce human values into academic curricula.

Key recommendations from the Conference included:

- *Establishing a national network of universities committed to values-based education.*
- *Developing a model curriculum that incorporates ethical leadership training.*
- *Creating a task force to support implementation through faculty development programs and periodic audits.*
- *Conducting community engagement initiatives to foster societal responsibility.*
- *This inaugural conference marked the beginning of a broader initiative to redefine Indian education, aligning with the principles of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 and government programs like Deeksharambh, Jeevan Kaushal, and the Indian Knowledge Systems Programme.*

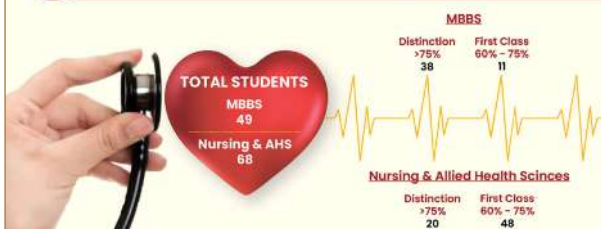

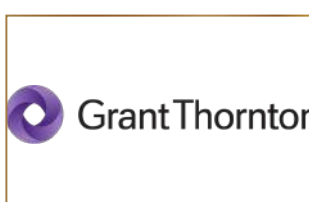
